
Subject – Implementation of Central Sector Scholarship Scheme of “Top Class Education” for SC/ST Students.

Subject: Introduction of a new Central Sector Scholarship Scheme of Top Class Education for Scheduled Castes (SCs) Students.

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware the Government of India has been implementing a number of programmes for social and economic development of persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes in the country. As a step forward, this Ministry has formulated a new Central Sector Scholarship Scheme of Top Class Education for Scheduled Caste (SC) students in the country. The primary objective of the scheme is to promote merit amongst the SC students for pursuing studies beyond 12th class in the designated institutes of excellence. The details of the designated institutes of excellence and the scheme is available on our website: www.socialjustice.nic.in.

2 The broad features of the scheme are -

- (i) Each of the identified institute has been allocated 10 seats in each discipline like engineering, medicine, management, law, specialized streams etc., except for commercial pilot training for which the number of seats allocated to each institute is 5;
- (ii) SC students, who secure admission in your institution according to the norms prescribed by you and whose total family income from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh per annum, will be eligible for the scholarship to the extent of the number of scholarships allocated to you.
- (iii) In case the number of students getting admission exceeds the number of awards, then the scholarship under the new scheme will be restricted to the top ones in the inter-se merit list. However, the remaining students from SC category admitted in your institute in different courses shall be eligible for the Post-Matric Scholarship (PMS) already in operation, provided such students are otherwise eligible;
- (iv) The scholarship would cover the following components of expenditure -

- (a) full fee and other non-refundable charges. However, in the case of private sector institutes and the private sector commercial pilot training institutes, there is a cap of fee of Rs.2.00 lakh per annum per student and Rs.3.72 lakh per annum per student respectively;
- (b) lodging & boarding charges at the rate of Rs.2220 per month per student or the actuals whichever is less;
- (c) books and stationery at the rate of Rs.3000 per annum per student or the actuals whichever is less; and
- (d) a latest P-IV computer system with all the necessary accessories like UPS, Printer, Multi-media etc. limited to Rs.45000 per student for the entire course of study.

The entire expenditure towards scholarship will be borne by this Ministry and the required funds will be released to your institute in one lump sum at the beginning of the each academic year, on receipt of details of SC students admitted.

It may be noted that SC students becoming eligible for scholarship should not be asked to pay anything on account of fee and other non-refundable charges, boarding & lodging, books & stationery and provision of computer. Immediately after admission, you may send details of SC students covered under the scheme in the enclosed format to this Ministry for releasing the necessary funds to your institute for the entire year.

You are requested to please take the following actions for smooth implementation of the scheme -

- (a) make necessary arrangements for providing books and stationery and a computer system to the SC students covered under the scheme;
- (b) go through the enclosed guidelines of the scheme and convey your acceptance for the same;
- (c) after admission, submit claim in the enclosed format for release of funds; and
- (d) after close of the academic year, submit audited accounts and utilization certificate for the funds released.

We shall feel happy to clarify any point of doubt relating to the scheme for which please do not hesitate to write to us.

**BROAD GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE INSTITUTES IN
IMPLEMENTING THE CENTRAL SECTOR SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME OF
TOP CLASS EDUCATION FOR SC STUDENTS**

1. 10 awards have been allotted to each of the 117 institutes in the field of Engineering, Medicine/Dentistry, Law, Management and Specialized Streams.
2. 5 awards have been allotted to each of the 10 institutes in the field of commercial pilot training;
3. SC students, who are having a total family income of up to Rs.2.00 per annum and who secure admission according to the prescribed norms of the institutes, will be awarded scholarship under the Scheme of Top Class Education for SC students to the extent of awards allotted;
4. In case the number of SC students exceeds the number of allotted awards, then the scholarship will be restricted to the top ones in the inter-se merit list. The remaining students will be given Post-Matric Scholarship (PMS), if otherwise eligible;
5. In the event of any awards becoming available on account of the student leaving the institute or for some other reasons, the same will be allotted to the next available students in the institute;
6. Scholarship will cover cost of fee and other non-refundable charges. However, in the case of private sector institutes, there will be a ceiling of Rs.2.00 lakh per student per annum. Likewise, there will be a ceiling of Rs.3.72 lakh per student per annum for commercial pilot training institutes;
7. In addition to covering the cost of fee and other non-refundable charges, as stated above, lodging and boarding charges @ Rs.2220 per month per student or actuals, whichever is lesser, books & stationery @ Rs.3000 per student per annum or actuals, whichever is lesser and provision of a latest P-IV computer along with UPS, Printer, Multimedia limited to Rs.45000 per student will be provided;
8. The institute shall not ask SC students covered under the scheme for payment of fee or other component covered under the scheme;
9. The institute will have to make necessary arrangements for provision of books & stationery and computer to SC students;
10. Immediately on admission, the institute would furnish details of students in the prescribed format to the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi for releasing the funds;

On receipt of details of eligible SC students in the prescribed format, funds covering all components of the scholarship will be immediately released by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi directly to the institute in one lump sum;

1. The amount will be released to the institute after receipt of acceptance, in the form of a sanction order, submission of pre-stamped bond (bond to be Rs. 10 stamp paper) and the amount considered is starting from submission of bond to the institute.

**CENTRAL SECTOR SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME OF
TOP CLASS EDUCATION FOR SC STUDENTS**
(Effective from June, 2007)

1. Background

The Finance Minister in his budget speech on the Union Budget 2005-06 made the following announcements –

“The key to empowering the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes is to provide top class education opportunities to meritorious students. The three on-going scholarship schemes for SC/ST students under the Central Plan – pre-Matric, post-Matric and merit-based – will continue.

To provide an added incentive, I propose a new window: a short list of institutes of excellence will be notified, and any SC/ST student who secures admission in one of those institutes will be awarded a larger scholarship that will meet the requirements for tuition fees, living expenses, books and a computer.

1.2 Accordingly, the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment had a re-look at the critical gaps in quality education and drafted a more liberal scholarship scheme in consonance with the budget speech, which can take care of the quality education for the SC students. It was considered apt to provide the new window to cover the funding for quality education to SC students up to degree/post degree level without any burden on the pupils or their family.

2. Objectives and Coverage

2.1 The Scheme aims at recognizing and promoting quality education amongst students belonging to SCs, by providing full financial support. The scheme will cover SC students for pursuing studies beyond 12th class.

2.2 The scheme will operate in all institutions notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.

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2.3 The SC students, who secure admission in the notified institutions, will be awarded scholarship to meet the requirements for (i) full tuition fee and non-refundable charges (there will be a ceiling of Rs.2.00 lakhs per annum per student for private sector institutions and Rs.3.72 lakhs per annum per student for the private sector flying clubs for Commercial Pilot Training). (ii) living expenses @ Rs.2220 per month per student subject to actuals, (iii) books and stationery @ Rs.3000 per annum per student subject to actuals and (iv) a latest computer with accessories like UPS, Printer, Multi-media limited to Rs.45000 per student as one time assistance during the course. The Institute will procure computers and supply to the awardees. Alternatively, the Institute may also consider re-imburement of expenses made by a student on purchase of the computer, limited to Rs.45,000/- provided, the computer and accessories are procured from a reputed manufacturer/supplier.

2.4 The scholarship, once awarded, will continue till the completion of the course, subject to satisfactory performance.

Eligibility

3.1 Those SC students who have secured admission in the notified institutions according to the norms prescribed by the respective institutions will be eligible for the scholarship under the scheme to the extent of the number of scholarships allocated to the institutes concerned. In case the number of students admitted exceeds the number of awards, then the scholarship will be restricted to the top ones in the inter-se merit list. The remaining students from SC category admitted in the institute in different courses shall be eligible for the Post-Matric Scholarship (PMS) administered by this Ministry as a Centrally sponsored scheme, provided such students are otherwise eligible for the said scheme. In case, the institute finds that the number of eligible candidates in the 1st year are less than the number of scholarships allotted to it, the balance scholarships may be offered to students studying in 2nd, 3rd and 4th year, etc. on the basis of inter-se merit of previous year's result giving priority to those with higher number of years

left to complete their respective course i.e. 1st year student is to get priority over the 2nd year student and so on.

3.2 The total family income of the student from all sources should not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh per annum.

3.3 The scholarship will become payable immediately after a student has secured admission and has started attending the classes.

3.4 The scholarship will be terminated if the student fails to pass the final examination of each year or any terminal examination prescribed. He will, however, remain eligible for the Post-Matric Scholarship.

4. Institutes of Excellence

The list of the reputed premier institutions to be covered under the Scheme is at Annexure-I. Any addition or deletion to the list shall be notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, as and when required, based on the recommendations of the Steering Committee.

5. Rates and the number of Scholarships

There will be 5 awards available per Flying Club for Commercial Pilot License Course and 10 awards each for all other institutions for various courses of Engineering, LLB, Management, etc. The maximum limit of scholarships per institute can be increased subject to an overall capping of 1250 scholarships per year.

6. Funding Pattern

6.1 The Scheme will be funded by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on 100% basis and the funds shall be released directly to the institution concerned.

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6.2 The funds may be released by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment in a single installment immediately after the admission.

7. General Provisions

7.1 The scholarship will become payable to SC students only upon securing admission in any of the institutions notified by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.

7.2 The students, who are awarded the scholarship under the scheme, shall have to pursue the study in the respective institution on whole time basis.

7.3 With a view to ensure access of all students to the provisions of this scheme, the institute will incorporate the salient features of the scheme in the prospectus in addition to putting the same on the website of the institute. The institute will select the SC students on the basis of merit and shall forward the applications of the eligible students in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-A for fresh students & Annexure-B for ongoing students) along with proof of admission and fee chargeable etc. to claim the scholarship. The Institute will not charge any fee, whatsoever, from the students.

7.4 After disbursement the institute will furnish an Utilization Certificate towards the amount received, which will include the signatures of the scholarship holders.

7.5 The performance of the SC students covered under the scheme shall be monitored regularly by the Head of the respective institution and the same shall be reported, through a report card, to the Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment at the end of each academic year.

7.6 The notified institutions shall submit progress reports of implementation of the Scheme to the Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment from time to time, as required.

7.7 Any institution violating the provisions of the Scheme and/or instructions issued by the Government of India will be denotified.

7.8 In the event of denotification/deletion of any institution, the scholarship will continue to be available to the SC students already admitted under the Scheme, if otherwise eligible, till completion of the course. However, no fresh seats will be allotted and funds released to such denotified institutes.

7.9 The general provisions of the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2005, will apply mutatis mutandis, and the institutions shall be bound by the general principles laid therein.

8. Review and monitoring

8.1 The progress of implementation of the scheme will be reviewed by a Steering Committee consisting of the following –

8.2 The Committee may invite an expert as a special invitee, as and when it deems necessary.

8.3 The Committee may recommend to the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment about addition or deletion of any institution based on their performance. For the purpose, the Committee may take into account the

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recommendations of the concerned bodies conducting entrance examination for admissions into such courses or having the administrative control over such institutes.

8.4 The Committee may periodically review the performance of the selected institutes on the basis of the academic results.
