

M.Sc (Chemistry) Program at IIT Mandi for the Academic Year 2017-18

Short Listing Criteria for Written Test:

1. The candidate should have applied against the advertisement in time. Candidates will have to submit a proof of their application for attending the written test.
2. B.Sc degree with Chemistry as the major subject.
3. **Percentage of B.Sc Marks/CGPA:** Candidates should have scored a minimum of 70% marks or CGPA 7 out of 10 or equivalent for the B.Sc final exam. For SC/ST candidates, the minimum requirement is 65% marks or CGPA 6.5 out of 10 or equivalent for the B.Sc final exam.
4. For candidates whose result is awaited, the percentage of marks or CGPA till last semester/year should satisfy the criteria No. 3 given above.
5. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
6. **Graduation year:** Candidates graduated before 2016 will not be considered.
7. **Age:** Date of birth should not be before 01-01-1994. For SC/ST candidates, age relaxation of upto 5 years will be permitted.
8. **Confirmation:** Candidates who satisfy all the above criteria and are planning to attend the written test should confirm their attendance through an email to sbsoffice@iitmandi.ac.in on or before 09th June, 2017. The subject line of the confirmation email should be "Confirmation_MSc Chemistry". Candidates should mention their application ID/application no. in the confirmation email for reference.

IMPORTANT: Only those candidates who confirm their attendance on or before 9th of June 2017 through email will be allowed to attend the written test for admission.

Important Notice:

1. Please note that no individual email or call letter will be sent to any candidate for attending the written test/interview.
 2. Interested candidates who satisfy the above short listing criteria are required to send their confirmation and attend the written test and interview for admission to be held at IIT Mandi.
 3. Only those candidates who qualify the written test will be called for an interview following the written test. The admission will be based on the performance of a candidate in the written test as well as in interview.
 4. The date(s) for written test and interview will be announced on our website.
 5. Candidates are requested to check our website frequently for more information.
 6. Candidates who fail to submit documents in support of their credentials at the time of written test/interview will be disqualified.
 7. Candidates whose results are awaited and are provisionally allowed to attend the written test and interview will have to submit the final mark sheet and degree certificate before admission. If they fail to secure final marks/CGPA as per the short listing criteria No. 3 given above will be disqualified.
