**Eligibility Criteria:**

- B.Sc. with Major in Chemistry /Applied Science.
- Minimum Marks in B.Sc. 55% or CGPA 5.5 (for SC/ST candidates 50% or CGPA 5.0)
- Candidates appearing for final examinations of their bachelor's program in 2017 can also apply and if selected can join the program provisionally. At the time of the interview / counselling they must bring a certificate in original from the Principal of Institute stating that:  
a) by 30<sup>th</sup> July 2018, s/he will have appeared for examination in all subjects required for obtaining his/her bachelor's degrees. In case such candidates fail to secure above mentioned marks, the provisional admission will be terminated with immediate effect.

**Mode of Selection:**

Shortlisted candidates must qualify written exam, which will be conducted by IIT Mandi, followed by interview.

**Deadlines:**

- The last date for submitting online application form is **07<sup>th</sup> May, 2018**.
- The list of shortlisted candidates will appear on our website latest by **25<sup>th</sup> May, 2018**.
- The interview will be conducted latest by **25<sup>th</sup> June, 2018**.
