NOTIFICATION

(HTRA Scholarship for Ph.D. & M.S. Scholars)

In suppression of the Office Order F.No. IIT Mandi/ADMN/RS-78/2014/2648-55 dated 01.05.2014, the grant of fellowship during the extension period to Ph.D. and M.S. Scholar shall be governed by the following:-

1. For Regular Ph.D. scholars:

- (i) Scholars who are getting HTRA scholarship from MHRD will be provided further scholarship from the institute during the period of extension, as given below:

1.	Graduate Degree in Professional Courses (BE/B.Tech. or Equivalent) and GATE or equivalent qualification OR Post Graduate Degree in Basic Sciences (M.Sc. or Equivalent) and NET qualified	07 years	Upto 5 th year	Rs.18,000/- per month.	6 th year: 50% of the last paid scholarship. 7 th year : Nil
2.	Post Graduate Degree in Professional Courses (M.E./M.Tech. or equivalent)	07 years	Upto 4 th year	Rs.20,000/- per month.	5 th year: 50% of the last paid scholarship. 6 th & 7 th year : Nil.

* Extension of duration will be based on the recommendation of the Doctoral Committee.

- (ii) The scholarship of Ph.D. scholars who are availing scholarship/fellowship from UGC/CSIR/other similar Funding Agencies/Projects, etc. will be as per the norms of the respective funding agency.
- (iii) During the extension period, the scholar will have to present the progress before the Doctoral Committee in the presence of Dean (Academics) on completion of six months of extension. The approval of the Doctoral Committee will be mandatory for the continuance of the scholarship beyond first six months of the extension.
- (iv) As per the practice at the Institute, such Ph.D. scholars are required to perform the TA duty of 8 Hrs./week during the extension period also.

2. For Regular M.S. scholars:

- (i) As per the provisions in the M.S. Ordinance & Regulations, the M.S. scholars, who are not able to submit their thesis within 3 years from the date of registration, may be given extension of one year. However, during the first six months of the extension period such scholars will be given only 50% of the last paid scholarship from the institute.
- (ii) No scholarship will be paid beyond six months of the extension period.
- (iii) During this period of extension, such scholars continue to perform usual duties as assigned to M.S. Scholars.

This bears the approval of the Competent Authority and is applicable with immediate effect.
