6. Candidates **must bring two copies of the call letter** issued to them along with at least one original photo ID viz. Aadhar Card, Voter ID Card, Driving License, PAN, Passport. One copy of the call letter will be collected in the examination hall.

Candidates are **NOT** allowed to carry any electronic gadgets/devices such as Calculator, Mobile Phone and Laptop, etc. in the examination hall. *The candidate should not bring any valuable material at Examination Centre as its safety and custody cannot be ensured.* Institute will not responsible for any loss.
