

PROTOCOL FOR SYMPTOMATIC PATIENT INSIDE THE CAMPUS

The following protocol may be followed, if anyone in the campus has symptoms of Covid-19. No need to panic, if you develop Covid-19 like symptoms.

- Any patient who has symptoms, suggestive of covid-19 infection and has travel history from containment zone/covid infected area should inform the health centre on emergency number (9816663003), irrespective of staying in quarantine centre/hostel /home at IIT Mandi campus.
- Individual should remain quarantined in his/her room/apartment and the Medical Unit will inform to the DSO/ BMO/ and call on 104 state helpline number for further course of action (**as per state/local administration procedures**).
- The dedicated 108 ambulance along with district administration staff will come to take the sample of the individual and his close primary contact (high risk contacts, ref. next page) and building/area will be sealed. And based upon the report result further course of action shall be taken.
- Those who are kept in quarantine/observation facility, and does not have any symptoms, medical team based upon their travel history can advise for their random sampling. This may be done after six days from their arrival in the campus and before joining the community, subject to approval from CMO Mandi.
- District mobile van with medical staff will visit the campus for Covid -19 sample collection. However, if the number of cases is more, then individuals can be referred to medical college Nerchowk for sampling.
- Treatment/isolation of any positive case will be as per the protocol of the government medical authorities.
