

NOTICE

(Merit-cum-Means (MCM) Scholarship for General/OBC students)

Applications on prescribed form are invited from the **General/OBC Category** students of B. Tech programme for the award of Institute *Merit-cum-Means* (MCM) Scholarship. The present value of *merit-cum-means* scholarship is **Rs.1000/- per month and the recipients would be exempted from paying the tuition fee.** The award is for one year and will be given from the date of registration in Odd Semester.

Only those students whose annual family Income from all sources is upto Rs.4.50 lakhs are eligible to apply for the scholarship.

The minimum eligibility requirement of Merit-cum-Means scholarship are:

- (i) CGPA must be 6.00 or more
- (ii) Earned credits should not be less than 18 times the number of semesters registered for.
(*not applicable on first year students*)
- (iii) SGPA in the previous semester must be 6.0 or more and
- (iv) The student should have passed all previous examinations and should not have any backlog or Fail grades.
- (v) Should not have been penalized due to unfair means/indiscipline

The number of MCM scholarship for each year and in each branch will be limited to 25% of the strength of the students in that particular branch in that year. In case there are vacancies in a branch and there are no wait-listed candidates belonging to that branch and year, then a combined merit list will be prepared of all wait-listed candidates of that year and the remaining scholarships will be distributed accordingly.

The criterion of merit for first year of B.Tech students would be All India Rank in the JEE Advanced.

Application form including valid family income certificate issued by the authorized officials in Revenue Deptt./SDM/DC/Tehsildar etc., affidavit, last semester grade card, category certificate, AIR Rank Card (1st year).
