Born and raised in India, Mr. Asava worked in senior/executive ranks for leading organizations such as Dell, Price Water house Coopers, Electronic Data Systems (EDS), General Motors, Chrysler Corporation, and Computer Task Group, and also held the position of President at two start-ups organizations, over the four decades of his corporate career in the United States. He retired as the Chief Strategy Officer at Perot Systems in the year 2010.

In 2017, Mr. Asava and his spouse founded HungerMitao, a grassroots movement focused on raising awareness about hunger in the U.S., improving community engagement, and channeling resources and contributions of communities in the fight against hunger.

In the year 2021, Mr. Raj and Ms. Aradhana (his spouse) were recognized as one of the top 100 philanthropists of Indian origin from across the globe in Indiaspora's 2021 Philanthropy Leaders list and in 2022, they both received the "Lifetime Achievement" award from the US President, Mr. Joe Biden for the thousands of hours they had put in to stand up to the HungerMitao movement.

In January 2023, Mr. Raj was selected as one of the 75 prominent Indo-Americans in the recently released "**Jewels of India: Leading Indo-American Personalities (Vol II)**".
