Senate 48.3.1 To consider the proposal for uploading the Ph.D. Thesis on Shodhganga portal.

With the approval of the competent authority, a relaxation up to one year may be granted.

A committee was constituted by the Dean (Academics) to prepare the guidelines for the Best Ph.D. Thesis Award. Dr. Maheshreddy Gade, Associate Dean (Research), presented the complete proposal and recommendations to the Senate. After due deliberation, the Senate approved the proposal in principle, Associate Dean (Research), will revise the proposal as suggested by the Senate. The Chairperson, Senate is authorised to approve the modified proposal.

Senate 48.3.4 To consider proposal for Credit distribution (IC Compulsory, IC Basket, Discipline Core, Discipline Elective) for students who applied for Exit Option from Dual Degree Bioengineering Program to BTech Bioengineering Degree program.

Dr. Prasad Kasturi presented the proposal regarding Credit distribution (IC Compulsory, IC Basket, Discipline Core, Discipline Elective) for students who applied for Exit Option from Dual Degree Bioengineering Program to BTech Bioengineering program.

After due deliberation, the Senate resolved to approve the proposal as placed at **Annexure – A, Pages No. 12 to 24.**

Senate 48.3.5 To consider proposal for the curriculum for those who chose exit option from IDD to B.Tech. Bioengineering for 2022 Batch.

Dr. Prasad Kasturi presented the curriculum for those who chose exit option from IDD to B.Tech. Bioengineering for 2022 Batch. After due deliberation, the Senate resolved to approve the proposal as placed at **Annexure – B, Pages No. 25 to 28.**

Senate 48.3.6 To consider proposal for IDD curriculum (with specialization) for 2019, 2020, 2021 & 2022 batches.

Dr. Prasad Kasturi presented the proposal for IDD curriculum (with specialization) for 2019,2020,2021&2022 batches.The IDD Programme in Bioengineering has a provision for specialization in either Biomedical Engineering or Computational Bioengineering. To earn a specialization, a student must complete three M.Tech. core courses (9 credits) and seven M.Tech. discipline electives (21 credits) aligned with the chosen specialization. Students who opted for courses across multiple specializations would receive an IDD degree in Bioengineering without a specialization.

After due deliberation the Senate resolved to approve the following:

1. All graduates of the 2019 and 2020 batches who have fulfilled the prescribed credit requirements for specialization shall be issued a certificate indicating the completed specialization, duly signed by the Chairman, Senate.
2. For the batches who are yet to graduate (2021 and 2022), the specialization will be mentioned in their degree certificates.

Senate 48.3.7 To consider the proposal for the Dual Degree in IIT Mandi B.Tech. EE and VLSI students to have one year Master Degree in Sorbonne University (UPMC), Paris, France.

Prof. Hitesh Shrimali presented a proposal to allow students pursuing the Dual Degree program in EE and VLSI at IIT Mandi to complete a one-year Master's degree at Sorbonne University (UPMC), Paris, France.

After a detailed discussion the Senate recommended the proposal as placed at **Annexure – C, Pages No. 29 to 47** for the consideration of the Board of Governors.

Senate 48.3.8 To consider the proposal for B.Tech. in General Engineering Curriculum.

Dr. Gajendra Singh presented the proposal regarding the curriculum for B.Tech. in General Engineering programme. After due deliberation the Senate resolved to approve the proposal with minor modifications. The revised proposal is placed at **Annexure – D, Pages No. 48 to 52**.

Senate 48.3.9 To consider Changes in the admission eligibility criteria for the MTech (R) and PhD Programs in Music & Musopathy.

Prof. Arnav Bhavsar, presented the proposal for changes in the admission eligibility criteria for the MS (Research) and PhD Programs in Music & Musopathy. After due deliberation the Senate resolved to approve the following:

1) For MS (Research) Programme in Music & Musopathy:

AIR ranking (B grade or higher) + Bachelor's degree as per IIT Mandi ordinances.

2) For PhD Programme in Music & Musopathy:

Inclusion of Alankar and other equivalent programs by a recognized board (as equivalent to a valid Master's degree) for PhD + Bachelor's degree as per IIT Mandi ordinances. These can be vetted by faculty members at IKSMHA with strong expertise in Music via their network.

Some examples of recognized boards or well-established organizations: Akhil Bharatiya Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mandal, Prayag Sangeet Samiti, Pracheen kala kendra, State music academies, Kalakshetra - level 5, Acharyanet - equivalent level etc.

3) Experience certificate for part-time candidates for minimum 2 years of experience by any of the following (from A to D):

(A) Certification of experience by an established organization for music education such as Acharyanet, Music Academy Madras, Swati Thirunal College of Music, Cleveland Tyagaraja Aradhana, Indian Fine Arts Academy, San Diego etc. which have a track record of over 10 years themselves.

(B) One recommendation letter stating the experience by other established music artists, including the candidate's music teachers.

(C) All India Radio/Doordarshan grading, as recognition from Govt. of India.

(D) Letter / Certificate from Sangeet Natak Akademi / Kalakshetra / Gandharva Mahavidyalaya or other Central/State Government recognized institutions or organizations such as those mentioned above in (2)

+

(E) Self attested letter stating the experience as a performing artist.

Prof. Pradeep Parameswaran, Chairperson of the committee presented the complete proposal/recommendations. After Due deliberation the Senate

recommended the proposal as placed at **Annexure – I, Page No. 170** for the consideration of the Board of Governors.

Senate 48.3.17 To consider the proposal w.r.t. NCC Air Wing activities at IIT Mandi.

A proposal w.r.t. Air Wing activities at the Institute was submitted by OIC, NCC Air-Wing, IIT Mandi to Dean (Students). Dean (Students) presented the proposal w.r.t NCC Air Wing activities at IIT Mandi. After due deliberation the Senate resolved to approve the following:

1. Inclusion of NCC in Extra-Co-Curricular activities: As per the ordinance of IIT Mandi, every new student has to participate in one of three extra co-curricular activities. NCC activities may be included as a co-curricular activity, and students enrolled in NCC may be exempted from the requirement of participation in other related co-curricular activities.
2. Attendance Relaxation: As students of NCC will continue to take part in NCC activities, relaxation to the extent of 10% is proposed to all NCC students. This shall neither be applicable for routine on-campus NCC activities nor this shall be an absolute blanket relaxation. Such relaxation will be provided only when a student is off-campus for any NCC activity or any major on-campus activity like a parade, special on-campus NCC sessions etc. The OIC, NCC may be authorized to issue a letter/certificate to participating NCC students, which can be produced to the course instructor to claim relaxation.

Senate 48.3.18 To consider the proposal for the classification of major and minor disciplinary actions based on severity.
